The Prize	Jackpot starts at \$4000 and increases by \$250 each week the Ace of Spades is not selected. Maximum Jackpot value is \$16750	
	Eligible entrants receive one ticket for each full \$5:00 spent on food and beverage sales at the bar between 5:00pm and 7:00pm on Thursdays during the Promotion Period. At 7:10pm each Thursday during the Promotion Period one ticket will be drawn from all tickets issued that day. Once drawn, the holder of the selected ticket will have two minutes to make themselves known to the drawer. The winner will be given the opportunity to throw one dart at the unturned cards on Chase the Ace board. If the dart lands on an unturned card, that card is revealed. If that card is the Ace of Spades, the Prize, as it stands prior to the dart being thrown, will be awarded to that player.
