



## **The Big Relief: Bush Fire Benefit Concert & Fundraiser**

On Monday February 1st, the Woorloo bushfire started 45 kilometres north-east of Perth, in the Shire of Mundaring, Western Australia.

By 2 February, the bushfire emergency had spread to Shires of Chittering and Northam, and the City of Swan.

By 6 February, the bushfire had travelled 26 km from its source, threatening houses in suburban Ellenbrook and Aveley, destroyed 86 homes and 2 fire trucks, and burnt over 11,000 hectares of land (for scale, Optus Stadium including all the surrounding parklands is about 19 hectares).

On the front line, were hundreds of members from volunteer bush fire brigades, some of whom left their own homes in the fire zone to help protect the homes of others.

Seeing the damage and hearing all of the stories from this close-knit community, the Parkerville Tavern has embarked on a mission to raise funds for The Lord Mayor's Disaster Relief Appeal and our local volunteer brigades to provide much needed funding to ensure they are better equipped for the next bushfire.



## Introducing The Big Relief

With a goal to raise \$100,000, there are two parts to our fundraising approach. Firstly, a mega raffle to be conducted online to maximise reach and secondly, a Benefit Concert at the Parkerville Tavern.

### Online Raffle

Raffle tickets will be available online with all proceeds going to the local brigades to purchase equipment and the Lord Mayor's Disaster Relief Appeal. Our aim is to sell 10,000 tickets and ticket value will be determined by the prize value.

### Benefit Concert

On Saturday 20th March, we will host a benefit concert, with entry at \$5 per person, and live music from 11am until 9pm. On the day there will also be silent auctions, door prizes and raffles. We have 10 bands playing, all of whom have donated their time to the cause.

## Where will the raised funds go?

Funds will be donated to

Local **Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades** to purchase much needed equipment including:

- Backup generators
- Hydrant installs at stations
- New station roller doors
- iPads to be installed in appliances (Fire trucks)
- 1,000 litre fire trailer
- PPE Racks
- 15amp compressor for rapid tyre inflation
- Mobile repeater for better coverage on fireground

Our goal is to help our volunteer brigades to be better equipped for future bush fires.

Funds will also be donated to the **Lord Mayor's Disaster Relief Appeal** to those who have suffered property losses as a result of the devastating fires.
